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Abstract:

INTRODUCTION Religious Moderation

In Indonesian, this word was then absorbed into moderation, which in the Big Indonesian Dictionary (KBBI) is defined as reducing violence, or avoiding extremes.

Based on research findings, the following is an analysis of the implementation of religious moderation and the development of the character of tolerance at the Syaichona Cholil Islamic Boarding School which is used as a reference for research information.

"Wa ma'arsalnaka illa rahmatan lil'alamin"

(وَمَا أَرْسَلْنَاكَ إِلَّا رَحْمَةً لِلْعَالَمِينَ)

The translation is, "And We did not send you (Muhammad) but as a mercy for all the worlds."

Because this concept confirms to all of us that Islam is full of love (mercy) and not full of hatred (curse), this concept will also bring the world atmosphere to a more peaceful and stable state, there will be no bloodshed, colonialism, let alone genocide. majority over minorities.

The concept of rahmatan lil'alamin shows that Islamic teachings are teachings that are full of love, peace and safety for all mankind, without distinction of race, religion or social background. Islam is expected to bring peace and goodness to all creatures, both humans and the universe as a whole. This concept teaches Muslims to behave fairly, respect each other, maintain peace, and create a harmonious society.

The Role of Islamic Boarding Schools in the Implementation of Islam Rahmatan Lil'Alamin
