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Abstract:

INTRODUCTION

Science and technology are developing very rapidly in the current era of globalization, its influence can be felt in various aspects of people's lives, especially in the field of education. In this study, data collection techniques were carried out by the

author through observation, interview and documentation instruments. To determine the validity of the data, researchers used triangulation techniques, namely source triangulation, method triangulation and time triangulation. The data analysis technique used in this research is interactive analysis according to Miles and Huberman, namely data collection, data reduction, data displays and conclusion drawing.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Development is an effort to improve technical, theoretical, conceptual and moral abilities according to needs through education and training. Development research is a process or steps to develop a new product or improve an existing product, which can be accounted for.

As the terminology that Islamic Education Institutions can be interpreted as a container or place where the process of Islamic education takes place. Abuddin Nata in his book Islamic Philosophy, reveals that the study of Islamic educational institutions (tarbiyah Islamiyah) is usually implicitly integrated with discussions of various types of educational institutions. Lessons from this hadith can be learned in the continuity of the existence of a forum for organizing education which has a good impact in providing insight into values and morals and civilization which brings the treasures of students' thoughts to develop so that they become noble human beings by the goals of Islamic education.

Competitiveness according to Sumihardjo is the word power in the sentence competitiveness means strength, and the word competitiveness means achieving more than others or being different from others in terms of quality, or having certain advantages. This means that competitiveness can mean the power to try to be superior in certain things that are done by a person, group or certain institution.

An educational institution has competitiveness. After all, it understands that knowledge must be managed because it must be planned and implemented. To increase the competitiveness of an organization or institution, it is necessary to manage knowledge, in addition to managing skills according to competence, to the needs of the organization or institution.

The concept of School Development in increasing the competitiveness of the modern era at MTs MiftahulMidadLumajang
